WHAT:

More than 40 MALTA (Metro Atlanta Landscape & Turf Association) members representing 13 companies have volunteered to landscape three (3) Clark Howard Habitat for Humanity homes on Saturday, Feb. 17. Landscaping will begin at 8 a.m. and last until the job is completed.

The members of MALTA felt it was important to bring a little shade and greenery to these properties. MALTA members have chosen low maintenance plant materials for the homes, including trees, shrubs and flowering plants. Due to the ongoing Georgia drought and the importance of conserving water, all materials will be drought tolerant, low water use plants.

Established in 1984, MALTA, with over 500 member companies, is committed to: promoting professionalism among the firms in the landscape industry; to increasing public awareness of the value of the professional landscape industry; and to fostering a spirit of cooperation among members and the industry. To that end, this project will promote the importance of greenspace to Atlanta, while demonstrating the use of drought tolerant plants.
